A short drive from Interlomas, Bosque Real, Tecamachalco, and Bosques de las Lomas — with direct connectivity to Santa Fe, Reforma, and Lomas de Chapultepec.

The only area open to renovation is the kitchen — original infrastructure remains fully functional, but presents a natural opportunity for the new owner to personalize the space to their taste.
