Imagine your own apartment in the oldest quarter of Mexico City, two blocks from the National Palace and facing the trees of Plaza de Loreto. Behind an 18th-century façade, an entrance hall opens onto a wide living room, a separate dining room and a proper closed kitchen. Every room is furnished in traditional Mexican style, collected piece by piece.

The Building

- Built in the 18th century by architect José Eduardo de Herrera, modified in the 19th century with additions in the 20th, per the records of INAH's National Coordination of Historic Monuments
- Two central courtyards
- Shared drying terrace on the fourth level

Ownership Structure

- The property is held under a co-ownership regime rather than a condominium regime. The buyer acquires a percentage of co-ownership rights together with the exclusive right of use over the apartment
- All-cash acquisition. Mortgage financing is not available for this ownership structure
- Pets welcome
- No parking space. Paid parking facilities available in the immediate area

Location & Connectivity

The apartment sits on Justo Sierra street, in the heart of Mexico City's Historic Center, facing Plaza de Loreto and beside the Antiguo Colegio de San Ildefonso. The National Palace and the Zócalo are two blocks away, with the Templo Mayor, the Metropolitan Cathedral and the antiquarian bookshops of Donceles all within a short walk. The area is a designated heritage conservation zone, served by Metro, Metrobús and a dense network of restaurants, museums and cultural venues, with Mexico City International Airport approximately 30 minutes by car.

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
